

Declarations to Build Faith

Mark 11:22-24

I have faith in God. I say to the mountain in front of me, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and I do not doubt in my heart, but I believe that the things I say will be done, therefore I will have those things that I say. I know that whatever things I ask when I pray, I believe that I receive *them*, and I will have *them*.

1 John 5:4

I am born of God, and I am victorious over the world, and this is the victory that conquers the world — even my faith!

Hebrews 10:23

I hold fast the confession of *my* hope without wavering, for He who promised *is* faithful.

Hebrews 10:38-39

I am just, and I live by faith. I am not of those who draw back to perdition, but of those who believe to the saving of the soul.

Hebrews 11:1-3, 6

My faith is the substance of things I hope for and the evidence of things I do not yet see. For by faith the elders obtained a good report. By faith, I understand that the worlds were framed by the Word of God, so that the things which are seen were not made of things which are visible.

And without faith, I know it is impossible to please God. As I come to God, I firmly believe that He *Is*, and that He *Is* a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

Isaiah 55:11

Every word that goes forth from God's mouth does not return to Him void. His Word accomplishes what He pleases, and it prospers *in the thing* for which He sent it.

Matthew 7:7-8

1 John 3:22-23

Matthew 21:21-22
