

Declarations for Wisdom and Understanding

Proverbs 1:7 I fear the LORD and this is the beginning of knowledge for me. I am not foolish, I do not despise wisdom and instruction.

Proverbs 18:15 I am a person of discernment. I acquire knowledge, for the ears of the wise seek it out.

Proverbs 2:1-11

I am God's son. I accept His words and store up His commands within me. I turn my ear to wisdom and apply my heart to understanding.

Indeed, I call out for insight and cry aloud for understanding, I look for it as for silver and search for it as for hidden treasure.

Because of this, I will understand the fear of the LORD and find the knowledge of God. For the LORD gives wisdom; from his mouth come knowledge and understanding. He holds success in store for the upright, he is a shield to those whose walk is blameless, He guards the course of the just and protects the way of his faithful ones.

Isaiah 11:2

James 1:5-8
