WHAT JUST HAPPENED?

YOU RECEIVED NEW LIFE

Salvation is God's gift, received by grace through faith in Jesus Christ.

● YOU ARE FORGIVEN

Jesus took the judgment for sin at the cross. Because you have repented and trusted Him, God forgives you and cleanses you from unrighteousness.

● YOU ARE FREE FROM SIN

Jesus sets you free from the power of sin. There is no condemnation for you in Christ Jesus, and the law of the Spirit of life makes you free from the law of sin and death.

● YOU ARE BORN AGAIN

Your new birth is a work of God's Spirit. God gives you spiritual life and makes you alive to fellowship with Him.

READ THE BIBLE

The Bible reveals Jesus, renews your mind, and teaches you God's ways. Begin with the Gospel of John. Read a manageable portion each day. Ask the Holy Spirit, 'What are You showing me, and how should I respond?' Do not read only to gather information. Read to know Jesus, believe His Word, and put it into practice.

PRAY

Prayer is fellowship with God. Speak honestly with your Father. Worship Him, thank Him, ask for what you need, and listen for His leading. Bring every worry to Him in faith. You do not need impressive words; God wants your heart. Make room for prayer every day and learn to recognize His presence.

BE BAPTIZED IN WATER

Water baptism is an act of faith and obedience to Jesus. It publicly declares that your old life has been buried with Christ and that you have been raised to walk in newness of life. Baptism does not earn salvation; it is your response to the salvation you have received. Ask the church to help you take this step.
