NOTES

Truth to carry into the week.

01 Life in the Holy Spirit is an ongoing surrender, not a one-time encounter.

- Believers open the gates of their hearts and lives to God, then keep them open through continued yielding.
- Walking by the Spirit means refusing to settle into a merely practical life after a past encounter with God. ([Galatians 5:16](#))
- God's presence brings conviction, healing, purification, and growth as His people continue responding to Him.

"This is a lifestyle. We keep this. We maintain this. It's not like a one and done."

02 Every believer carries a distinct identity and purpose.

- Believers carry the light of Jesus into ordinary life, and the Church Body works together as God uses each person's spiritual fingerprint to strengthen others. ([Matthew 5:14-16](#); [1 Corinthians 12:12-27](#))

"You are something. You are."

03 Adonai reveals God as personal Lord and Master.

- Abraham addressed God as Adonai alongside His covenant name, recognizing both relationship and lordship. ([Genesis 15:1-2](#))
- Calling God Lord includes reverence, worship, obedience, and willing service.
- True surrender places every area of life beneath His rightful authority.

“God is my lord and my master. He is worthy of not just my awe and worship, but my obedience and my service.”

04 Faith understands the authority of Jesus and responds to His Word.

- The centurion recognized that Jesus could command healing because he understood authority. ([Matthew 8:5-13](#))
- Jesus is King of Kings and Lord of Lords; every other authority remains beneath Him. ([Revelation 19:14-16](#))
- Belonging to the Lord brings correction and discipline, but also His mercy, care, and protection. ([Isaiah 43:1-2](#))

“Lord, I’m not worthy that you should come under my roof, but only speak a word and my servant will be healed.”

05 Jehovah Jireh is the Lord who sees, knows, and provides.

- On Mount Moriah, Abraham obeyed God, and the Lord provided a ram in place of Isaac. ([Genesis 22:1-14](#))
- God’s provision is rooted in His complete vision: He sees the whole path while people see only portions.
- The Lord is already aware of every need, every act of obedience, and everything placed upon the altar.

“The Lord sees. And the Lord knows. And the Lord will provide.”

06 Trust replaces worry when God's kingdom remains first.

- Jesus directs believers away from anxiety about daily needs and toward the Father's faithful care. ([Matthew 6:25-34](#))
- Seeking first God's kingdom and righteousness establishes the proper order for every other concern. ([Matthew 6:33](#))
- God supplies needs according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus. ([Philippians 4:18-20](#))

"The Lord is not unaware of your need."

STUDY [Matthew 6:25-34](#); [Philippians 4:18-20](#)

07 Perseverance keeps obeying, serving, and trusting the Lord through hardship.

- Faith does not carry man-made worry; it trusts the Lord, seeks His kingdom, and obeys Him.
- Difficulty is not permission to surrender to defeat or remain down after a fall.
- Adonai remains Lord, and Jehovah Jireh continues to care for His people as they keep moving forward.

"You got to keep going in this thing."
