NOTES

Truth to carry into the week.

01 Your words steer the course of your life.

- The mouth speaks from the abundance of the heart, so renew your mind until your words agree with God. ([Matthew 12:34](#); [Romans 12:2](#))
- The tongue is like a rudder: though it is small, it directs the course of an entire life. ([James 3:4-5](#))
- Speak and declare the Word of God instead of allowing feelings, fear, or superstition to determine your direction.

"Our words determine our life. Our words determine our path."

02 The Word of the Lord is always coming; position yourself to hear.

- Jeremiah learned that the Word of the Lord comes again and again; God is not silent or distant. ([Jeremiah 1:1-4](#))
- Remove unforgiveness and distraction, then pursue His voice through Scripture, worship, and prayer.

- The Word is not confined to a church building. Wisdom cries out, and God desires to speak personally to His people. ([Proverbs 1:20-23](#))

“The Word of God is always flowing.”

03 God’s call was established before your weakness had a voice.

- Before Jeremiah was formed, God knew him, sanctified him, and ordained him for His purpose. ([Jeremiah 1:5](#))
- The call of God is not based on age, background, merit, or natural ability; it begins with what God has spoken. ([Psalm 139:16](#); [1 Timothy 4:12](#))
- Reject an identity built around “I cannot.” God answers every excuse with His presence, His direction, and His Word. ([Jeremiah 1:6-8](#))

“Before you could say anything, the Lord chose you, and the Lord called you.”

04 God puts His Word in surrendered mouths and gives it highest authority.

- The Lord touched Jeremiah’s mouth and put His words there; surrendered speech carries what Heaven has authorized. ([Jeremiah 1:9](#))
- The Word roots out, pulls down, destroys, throws down, builds, and plants. ([Jeremiah 1:10](#))
- Believers are not called to be ruled by problems; they are called to speak the Word God has given them for the season.

“You were born to speak to your problems.”

STUDY [Jeremiah 1:9-10](#)

05 His Word burns through discouragement and keeps you faithful.

- Jeremiah wanted to stop speaking, but the Word was like a fire shut up in his bones. ([Jeremiah 20:9](#))
- God gives grace to endure rejection, remain watchful, and fulfill the work He has assigned. ([2 Timothy 4:3-5](#))
- Faith expects God to perform His Word; faithfulness remains in position until the promise is fulfilled.

“Faith says God’s going to do it. Faithfulness says, ‘I’m going to be here when God does it.’”

06 God watches over His Word; prepare, arise, and keep speaking.

- The almond branch revealed that God is awake, alert, and actively watching over His Word to perform it. ([Jeremiah 1:11-12](#))
- His Word carries the power to accomplish what He sent it to do and to prosper in its purpose. ([Isaiah 55:11](#))
- Prepare yourself, arise, and speak without drawing back; opposition cannot prevail against the one God has sent. ([Jeremiah 1:17-19](#))

“God doesn’t call any shooting stars.”
