## NOTES

## Truth to carry into the week.

### 01 Jehovah Rapha reveals the Lord as the One who heals, repairs, and restores what is broken.

- At Marah, God showed Moses a tree, made bitter waters sweet, and revealed Himself as the Lord who heals. ([Exodus 15:25-26](#))
- Jehovah Shalom describes wholeness and peace, while Jehovah Rapha emphasizes God's healing and mending work.
- Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever; His character as healer has not changed. ([Hebrews 13:8](#))

*"He is the Lord that heals us."*

### 02 Jesus demonstrates the Father's compassion and willingness to heal.

- Jesus was moved with compassion and healed the sick who came to Him. ([Matthew 14:14](#))
- Great multitudes brought people with many physical needs, and He healed them. ([Matthew 15:30-31](#))
- Healing in the Gospels reveals God's goodness rather than a distant or reluctant heart.

***“There is absolutely nowhere in the New Testament, there’s nowhere that it was not God’s will to physically heal people.”***

### **03 Faith reaches toward Jesus while remaining anchored in who He is.**

- The woman with the issue of blood reached for Jesus’ garment and received healing through faith. ([Mark 5:25-34](#))
- The healing in His wings points believers toward the righteousness and restoring power found in Him. ([Malachi 4:2](#))
- Circumstances do not redefine God; faith continues to honor Him and trust His character.

***“God is still God. The Lord is still the healer.”***

### **04 Forgiveness removes bitterness and makes room for inward healing and wholeness.**

- Unforgiveness must be surrendered instead of being permitted to contaminate the heart.
- Believers choose forgiveness and love because Christ has freely forgiven them. ([Ephesians 4:31-32](#))
- Healing includes the inner life as God restores hope, joy, peace, and soundness of mind.

***“Unforgiveness has no place in my life.”***

### **05 Jesus commissions believers to minister healing freely, boldly, and humbly.**

- The disciples were told to heal the sick and freely give what they had freely received. ([Matthew 10:8](#))
- Signs follow believers as they lay hands on the sick and expect recovery. ([Mark 16:15-18](#))
- Healing ministry points people to Jesus, so every gift must operate without pride or self-promotion.

***“Freely you have received, freely give.”***

## 06 The Holy Spirit works through yielded believers to bring healing to people in need.

- The early church witnessed signs, wonders, and healing through the hands of the apostles. ([Acts 5:12-16](#))
- God worked unusual miracles through Paul as sickness and oppression left people. ([Acts 19:11-12](#))
- Believers can pray, lay hands on the sick, and trust the Holy Spirit to demonstrate the goodness of Jesus.

***“Your hands are anointed to heal.”***

## 07 A consistent voice of faith keeps pointing people toward God’s unchanging character.

- Doctors can be instruments of healing, but God remains the final authority and source of hope.
- Delay and discouragement do not change who God is or cancel His compassion.
- Believers strengthen others by continuing to speak hope, pray, and agree with God’s Word. ([Hebrews 13:8](#))

***“Be consistent. Because somebody else might not be consistent. But be a consistent voice.”***
